

Official visit of the Mayor of San Antonio, Texas, to Mexico City

On Monday, November 9, in the Salón Benito Juárez of the Old City Hall, Mexico City Mayor, Mr. Miguel Angel Mancera, served as witness of honor, along with his counterpart from San Antonio Texas, Ms. Ivy Taylor, of the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding to establish the Global Cities Economic Partnership, which was signed by the Mexico City Secretary of

This agreement aims to formalize a bilateral relationship for job growth

and economic opportunities in both cities, particularly in advanced industries through joint initiatives related to commerce, investment, and innovation.

During the event, Mr. Mancera highlighted the leadership role that Mexico City has taken in the fight to raise the minimum wage, in order to provide better economic conditions to the capital's population.

He also called on the business sector to equally distribute the wealth generated in our city, as a way to achieve equal economic development.
